REQUIREMENTS:

A.) To qualify for the Barbara Whitehead Silva Scholarship, parent/guardian or applicant must be a member of First Citizens' Federal Credit Union.

The Champion Family Scholarship is available only to immediate family members of Champion account holders (Teachers, EMT, Police, Firefighters).
