"We wish them well and look forward to their continued success in the pursuit of their goals and dreams."



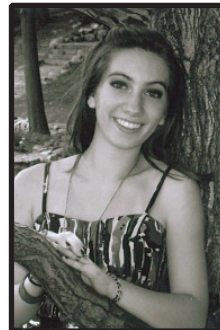
