

Contest Rules – Teacher Appreciation Gift Card Giveaway:

1. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. Open only to legal U.S. residents of Massachusetts. For a copy of these complete official rules, go to www.firstcitizens.org. Must be 18 years or older to enter. Promotion takes place from August 15, 2022, through August 26, 2022.

2. ENTRY: Must visit our Facebook and two teachers in the comments. Two random winners will be selected to receive a \$100 Visa gift card.

3. ALTERNATE METHOD OF ENTRY: To enter the SouthCoast Community Foundation Giveaway without engaging with our website, handprint on a 3" x 5" card: First Citizens' Federal Credit Union Teacher Appreciation Gift Card Giveaway, your full name, address, ZIP code, daytime phone number, email address and nomination; then mail it, with first-class postage affixed, in a hand-addressed envelope no larger than 4-1/8" x 9-1/2" (#10 envelope) to First Citizens' Federal Credit Union, Attn: Marketing, 200 Mill Rd., Ste. 100, Fairhaven, MA. Limit one entry submission per outer mailing envelope. All entries must be postmarked by August 15, 2022. Sponsor is not responsible for damaged, lost, late, misdirected, postage-due, incomplete, or illegible entries. Facsimile and mechanically reproduced entries will not be accepted. All entries submitted become the sole property of First Citizens' Federal Credit Union and will not be returned. Prizes will be awarded at the end of the contest period. The odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received. Participants agree to be bound by the Official Rules.

4. A total of two (2) winners will be randomly selected on August 19, 2022, to receive two (2) \$100 Visa gift cards. Two (2) more winners will be randomly selected on August 26, 2022 to receive two (2) \$100 Visa gift cards. Winners must be from the Bristol, Plymouth, Barnstable, Norfolk and/ or Duke County. FCFCU reserves the right to substitute any prize with another prize of equal or greater value. First Citizens' Federal Credit Union employees, Board of Directors, Officers or persons in their immediate family are not eligible.

5. Winner will be notified via Facebook. In the event of noncompliance, if the winner chooses to not receive the prize, it will be forfeited, and an alternate winner will be selected. Prize is not

transferable. No prize substitutions.

6. FCFCU has the right to disqualify any winner. Acceptance of prize constitutes permission to use the winner's name, likeness, videotape, and photo for promotional and publicity purposes at no additional compensation unless prohibited by law. The prize winner is solely responsible for any local, state, or federal taxes, and any other fees or costs.
